

RESERVE FIREFIGHTER. \$10.50/hr. or the minimum hourly rate as defined by CAL OES, depending on assignments. The City of Atwater is recruiting for Reserve Firefighter positions in the Fire Department. Under general supervision, to support firefighting and rescue operations in response to fires, disasters, and other emergency incidents while protecting both life and property; and to perform related work as required. FLSA Status: Non-exempt. Bargaining Group: Unrepresented.

Minimum qualifications include but are not limited to: First aid methods and techniques; ability to cope with stressful situations firmly, tactfully, and with respect of individual rights; ability to work under adverse conditions that may require a high level of physical exertion; and ability to perform all designated firefighting and disaster response tasks under hazardous or dangerous conditions. Incumbents shall be at least 18 years of age at time of appointment. Completion of First Responder Medical with CPR AED certificate, CSTI Hazardous Materials First Responder Operations certificate, Confined Space Awareness certificate, and Equal Employment Opportunity Course within the first month of employment provided by the City of Atwater. Completion of the First Year Firefighter Task Book. Equivalent to graduation from high school. Possession of a valid California driver's license. Upon issuance of a conditional job offer, qualifying candidates are required to successfully complete and pass a criminal record background clearance, credit check, medical examination, and drug screen.
